

SPECIAL CALL MEETING NOVEMBER 6, 2020

Be it remembered that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Ocean Springs met in a Special Call meeting at City Hall in the City of Ocean Springs at 2:30 p.m. on November 6, 2020. The Mayor presiding, Aldermen Gill, Authement, Bellman, Cox, Papania and Blackman were present. Let the minutes reflect that Alderman Impey is attending this meeting by teleconference pursuant to Section 25-41-5 of the Mississippi Code. Let the minutes also show that there is a speakerphone in the meeting room and that all those present are able to hear Alderman Impey. Also present were City Attorney Nicole Sullivan, City Clerk Patty Gaston, Deputy City Clerk Vicky Hupe, Police Chief Mark Dunston, Fire Chief Derek McCoy, Human Resources & Risk Management Director Mindy McDowell, Building Official Darrell Stringfellow, Public Works Director Allan Ladnier and Executive Assistant to the Mayor & Board Meggan Brown.

The Mayor called the meeting to order.

The Special Call Meeting is for the purpose of any and all matters pertaining to Hurricane Zeta disaster assistance, assessments and reimbursements.

The Public Works Director gave an update on debris pickup both with City trucks and Mapco Services. He said he would like to continue as is until next Wednesday and reassess. He said by next Wednesday, he hopes the Mapco trucks could be reduced to only 10. Alderman Blackman requested a reassessment on Monday morning and on Wednesday.

Aldermen Gill and Blackman said the Public Works Director should be directing Mapco trucks to areas with large debris piles and should keep track of where they will be each day. Alderman Papania said Ward 4 has not received the cleanup that other Wards have and only saw two trucks in Ward 4 this morning.

The Public Works Director said he will reassess Monday by noon. Alderman Gill asked if Mapco will be assisting with the second pass of cleanup. The Public Works director said Mapco will complete the first big pass and Public Works will complete the second pass. The City Clerk responded that Mapco trucks would not make money doing second pass clean up, they are here for the big loads to assist the City. Alderman Cox said for the Public Works Director to allow Mapco to pick up big piles only and then Public Works will do the rest as it is costing too much to keep going with Mapco in his opinion. The City Clerk requested the Executive Assistant

to the Mayor & Board put out a public notice to inform the big non-city trucks are here for big piles only and we appreciate their patience with the cleanup.

Alderman Papania asked about the upcoming City holiday, Veterans Day. The City Clerk said that Public Works will continue to work the cleanup and will get eight extra hours of holiday pay.

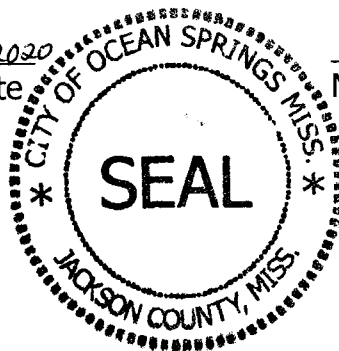
Alderman Impey asked if all arrangements have been finalized for the Peter Anderson Festival. The Mayor responded yes.
