



Downtown Traffic-Travel-Parking Study – June 2022

As Ocean Springs continues its growth as a desirable destination for visitors and permanent residents alike, pressure points on the downtown area's vehicular infrastructure are becoming more and more apparent. This study, primarily focusing on parking, congestion and circulation within the downtown core and Porter Avenue, is intended to illustrate those challenges with concise data that will influence decision making in the future.

Funded by the State Transportation Improvement Plan (STIP) through MDOT and Gulf Regional Planning Commission (GRPC), this report reflects a comprehensive study undertaken by Dale Partners Architects. This study is broken into two parts: PART 1 – Inventory and Analysis and PART 2 – Conceptual Proposals.

This document will be used to evaluate potential improvements to be considered for implementation and funding requests.
